I can sequence the life of a blackcurrant!

Hello, blackcurrant! How did you get here?

Exercise 1: Look closely at the pictures. Now read the sentences below very carefully. Which sentence goes with which picture? With a partner can you match the sentence to the correct picture.

- We put a blackcurrant item in our shopping baskets
- The berries are driven to a factory to be packed or squeezed into juice
- Buds grow on the bush and turn into flowers
- The berries swell and change colour
- The flowers fall off, leaving bunches of small berries
- Blackcurrants grow on a bush in the soil
- Machines harvest the blackcurrants
- The berries are delivered to the shops in their new form (fresh fruit, juice, yoghurts, jam etc)



Exercise 2: As they grow, blackcurrants change from green to red to purple. Look at the pictures again. Can you see which berries should be which colour? Great! Colour the berries in with green, red and purple pencils or crayons. Now colour in everything else.

Exercise 3: Make a 'currant cartoon' – cut out the pictures and stick them onto a piece of paper in the right order.
